

**Morgan County Commission Meeting  
South Morgan Volunteer Fire Company (SMVFC)  
March 9, 2015**

The County Commission met with representatives from South Morgan Volunteer Fire Department to discuss the Emergency Radio Equipment Issue Agreement.

The County Commission received an email detailing changes SMVFC requests be made to the agreement. The County Commission read each paragraph in the email and agreement while discussing the issues with SMVFC.

President Close stated that Morgan County has moved forward with a radio system and we want everyone to be able to participate.

Commissioner Tuttle stated that he thinks SMVFC just wants to make sure there is no confusion regarding terms of the agreement.

The Commission continued to review the email and a lot of the issues were already resolved. Jody McClintock, County Administrator, will make the requested revisions to the agreement and the Commission will resubmit to SMVFC. The Commission thanked the representatives for taking the time to come in and discuss the agreement.
