Gordon MacLeod motioned to approve minutes, Phil King seconded, motion passed 8-0.

Biddy Buddy wrap up: Brought in \$10,225 had \$5,900 in expenses. Sent an email asking coaches for feedback on what to change for next year to make the season better. Received a few replies. Paw Paw would like their own portable hoops. Will check on prices.

Little League 522 Parking lot: 1 ½ " stone rolled will cost \$675. \$1920 to gravel the whole circle. Board had a consensus to address the upper road way for \$675 and review entire parking lot repair till after the season once all emergency repairs and maintenance are completed.

All Ball Field Emergency Maintenance done has cost \$3,900. Budget approved for Little League: \$1,500 for field maintenance, \$2,000 for fencing, \$2,500 for field dirt, \$4,000 for repairs.

Dug-out Roof, first priority- \$1,000.00 per roof.

Gordon MacLeod motioned to transfer \$2,500 from field dirt to repairs and maintenance. Dawn Beal seconded, motion passed 8-0.

Foul Ball netting: Each season the nets get put up and taken down. There is a way to keep them up all year long and stored under the eaves of the building for \$500. Jason Didawick will research. Tabled until a later date.


Soccer Field Drawings: Discussed both options, all agreed to go with original drawings.
