

**MORGAN COUNTY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY  
MINUTES OF MONTHLY BOARD MEETING  
June 14, 2022**

The June monthly meeting of the MCSWA was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by John Spies. Present were Morgan County Solid Waste Authority Board Members John Spies, Glenn Horr, Steve Davison, Center Manager JR Timmons, Center Assistant Brenda Timmons and Coordinator Becky Barkley. Judy Fisher and Margaret Gordon were absent.

Coordinator Becky Barkley took minutes.

The minutes from the MCSWA May Meeting were reviewed by the board. John Spies approved the minutes.

The May financials were reviewed and discussed by the board and approved by Glenn Horr.

Center Manager JR Timmons reported that another post had been damaged by Apple Valley Waste. Apple Valley Waste has been notified and requested pictures of the damage. John took pictures and will send to AVW.

The annual Educational Conference in Glade Springs will be attended this October by John Spies. Coordinator Becky Barkley will take care of registering him for the event.

The CED Event was held and a moderate success. Over 8900 lbs of electronics were recycled. Center Manager JR mentioned that many were frustrated that we could not accept the older 'tube' televisions. Discussion on whether we should use the remaining grant balance for a second CED event was held. The Grant monies will expire at the end of September. Grant funds would only cover half of the hauling expense of \$4000. The MCSWA would have to cover the remaining \$2000. John Spies didn't think there would be enough interest in a second event to justify the expense. A final decision will be made at the next board meeting in July.

The Paper Shredding Event was a success. We were billed at a substantially higher rate than previous years. Upon inquiry, All-Shred stated that they had increase their rates from \$150/hr to \$250/hr.

A tentative date of July 14<sup>th</sup> was set for a summer clean up day.

Steve Davison moved to adjourn the meeting at 4:45 pm.
