

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Morgan County Commission and the Morgan County Ambulance Authority will conduct a Public Hearing on March 17, 2016, 7:00 p.m. at the Warm Springs Middle School Cafeteria, 271 Warm Springs Way, for the purpose of receiving public comments regarding proposed changes to the Morgan County Special Emergency Ambulance Service Fee Ordinance. A brief summary of proposed changes are as follows:

Morgan County, West Virginia Special Emergency Ambulance Service Fee Ordinance:

Definitions: Including but not limited to revisions/additions to definitions of Unit, Owner, Users, Delinquent User, Approved Annual Budget Estimate, Basic Life Support, Advanced Life Support, Special Emergency Ambulance Service Fee, Nearest Certified Medical Facility, Emergency Ambulance Rates, EMS Agency and MCEMS Board; Removal of the Definition of Emergency Interagency and Non-Emergency Transports.

Section One: Establishment of Special Emergency Ambulance Service Fee: including but not limited to a Revision of Annual Special Emergency Ambulance Service Fee to Once Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) dollars; Remove second paragraph; Revisions to third paragraph relating to Exoneration process.

Section Two: EMS Board Budget Development: Including but not limited to the addition of first paragraph relating to budget process; Revisions to second paragraph relating to financial reporting and budget process.

Section Three: Billing and Collection procedures: Section Three A: Including but not limited to addition of paragraph relating to collection of unpaid fees; Inclusion of \$150.00 Ambulance Service Fee; Section Three B: Including but not limited to 911 Emergency Medical Services Transport Charges.

Section Four: Management of Revenues: Including but not limited to revision to expenditures of revenues; Fiscal year proceeds.
