Pursuant to Chapter 19, Article 20A, Section 2 of the West Virginia Code, "Whoever owns, keeps, or harbors a dog or cat within the boundaries of any county in the State of West Virginia shall have such dog or cat properly vaccinated or immunized against rabies", and in order to help contain the spread of rabies and help minimize the chance of contact to the residents of Morgan County, the MORGAN COUNTY COMMISSION, and Dr. Doyle will be sponsoring rabies clinics at the following locations:

When you get your animals vaccinated for "Rabies" you must keep your certificates available and the rabies tag "MUST BE" put on the animals collar.

It is "NOT" the responsibility of the Vet to keep these records handy for the citizens of Morgan County.
