Call to Order

Joel Tuttle called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Review and Approval of Agenda

Commissioner Forney made a motion to approve the agenda. President Tuttle voted yea. Commissioner Forney voted yea. Commissioner Clark voted yea. Motion carried.

Items from the public

Michael McCreade, President of the Paw Paw Fire Hall, expressed his concerns when their staffed ambulance goes out on a call and then one is needed for Paw Paw. He said they must wait for 30 minutes until another unit can be on scene. The second due always takes patients back to War Memorial and then has to be transferred to another hospital, costing residents more. He is asking if Paw Paw can have another paramedic that can go with another driver. Commissioner Forney said he will add this topic to the next EMS meeting.

Ron Davis added that he appreciates everything the Commission has contributed to Paw Paw. He said that they are continuing to work on park and water projects. They received \$725,000 from the Governor to build a Community Center. Bids go out in March, but they are hoping they can request more funds to complete the project. Commissioner Forney told Ron to let the Commission know if a letter of support would help and we would be more than happy to do that.

Administration Items

Approval of meeting minutes

Commissioner Clark made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from 2/5/2026. President Tuttle voted yea. Commissioner Forney voted yea. Commissioner Clark voted yea. Motion carried.

Warm Spings PSD Board Appointment

Jason Didawick will be replacing Charlie Johnson. The Commission thanks Charlie for his years of service on the board. The Commission believes Jason will be a good asset to the

board with his prior work experience in water and sewer. Commissioner Clark made a motion to appoint Jason Didawick to a 6-year term to the Warm Spring PSD Board expiring January 31, 2031. President Tuttle voted yea. Commissioner Forney voted yea. Commissioner Clark voted yea. Motion carried.

Emergency Absentee Voting Policy

Commissioner Forney made a motion to adopt the Emergency Absentee Voting Policy. President Tuttle voted yea. Commissioner Forney voted yea. Commissioner Clark voted yea. Motion carried.

Emergency Absentee Voting Commissioners

Commissioner Forney made a motion to approve Cathy Spielman and Charity Sullivan as Democrat(No Party) and Mark Hill and Lisa Webster Republican Commissioners for Emergency Absentee Voting. President Tuttle voted yea. Commissioner Forney voted yea. Commissioner Clark voted yea. Motion carried.

Agenda Items

Board Of Equalization Continuation

Joshua Cannon of 63 Noble Lane came before the Commission because he believes his property is valued too high at \$236,700. He has no paved driveways or attached garages and majority of his property is under powerlines and has water run-offs. He believes a fair assessment would be \$225,000. Bob Ratcliff explained that the state tells them year after year properties are undervalued. He explained that other houses selling high will make his value higher. President Tuttle asked Assessor Debbie Weaver if she believed that \$225,000 was a fair value. Debbie said she believes the fair value is what was presented at \$236,700. Commissioner Forney made a motion to change the value from \$236,700 to \$225,000. President Tuttle voted nae. Commissioner Clark voted nae. Commissioner Forney voted nae. Motion failed.

Administrator's Report

Marshall Younker presented the Commission with the SLCGP grant award. The County was awarded \$159,950 for Cyber IT funding; however this does not cover the servers that need replaced in the 911 Center. The cost for the needed servers are \$97,759. Commissioner Forney made a motion to authorize County Administrator Misty to contact CNB and add \$97,759 to the lease currently in place. In the event that CNB says no, the cost of the servers will be paid out of 911 carry-over. President Tuttle voted yea. Commissioner Forney voted yea. Commissioner Clark voted yea. Motion carried.
