Highlighted items from the budget review are- the Jail Bill is \$20,000-\$25,000 monthly, this month it is \$40,000 and is usually higher in winter months, PEIA insurance rates will increase 3% this year, the Commission will need a vehicle in the future, and there may be Tax Rollback which then would require a public hearing.
