Administrator's Report

Over the past weekend there was a 911 Communication malfunction. The state system went down resulting in all radios not working. Marshall, 911 Director, gave a quote estimate for the equipment that will prevent this problem from happening again. A new power supply module that bridges audio between Berkely Springs Tower and Old PSAP at \$4,818 to be paid from the 911 Tower Fund. Jason Hoover, Emergency Management Director, has joined a Mutual Aid Agreement with Fredrick County, MD.
