The meeting was called to order by Chair Tuttle at 7:01pm.

The agenda was approved by consensus (as amended).

There were no previous meeting minutes presented.

Financial reports were presented, reviewed, and approved. (Moved-Fincham, Seconded-Omps)

<u>Public Comment</u>: Tom Zanhow made a request to the Board that rent should be waived for little league and soccer fields and subsidized by Board or Morgan County Commission. Board discussion was that the Little League and the Youth Soccer League pay rent often times so that they have some control for field use etc. Some other public citizens were present and spoke during agenda items.

#### Amended Item - Friends of Rail Trail

David O'Connell presented to the Board a request to form a partnership or a sub-committee with Parks and Rec.

#### Little League Pavilion Roof Repair Estimate

Randy Stotler, Morgan County Facilities Director, requested funds in writing for the needed repair. After discussion, a motion was made to allocate \$4,000 for the repair. After the repair, a request may be made for the cost to be reimbursed by the County Commission. (Moved-Close, Seconded-Shives)

#### FY 2022 MCC Hotel/Motel Request

On a motion by Close, seconded by Omps, the Board unanimously approved a request to be made for \$45,000, which will be prepared and presented to the Commission by Mr. Close at the appropriate time.

#### Skate Park

The Board discussed that the skate park property has sold and the equipment will need to be relocated.

#### Adult Softball

A request was made for fall ball from end of August through October. The Board approved the use at the same rent as last year with use of the restroom and no overnight activities and no alcohol use (Moved-Close, Seconded-Shives)

#### **Youth Soccer Clinic**

Michael Powell approached the Board regarding using the soccer field for a 7-9-year-old and a 10-13-year-old clinic with assistance from high school soccer players through June and July. The clinic will be free or have a small fee to cover costs only. A motion was approved for the use (Moved-Tuttle, Seconded-Shives)

#### Morgan County United Soccer Team

Mr. Powell informed the Board of his intent to start a soccer club team for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade girls from the end of July through November and presented a document with specifics. Mr. Powell asked if the program could "run through parks and recreation" such that that MCPR would assist with registration etc. The Board approved the request (Moved-Shives, Seconded-Omps)

#### Amended Item – Swimming Lessons

Director Beal presented to the Board a proposal from Ben Forrest for swimming lessons every Tuesday in June at the Berkeley Springs State Park for a fee of \$600 for two classes each Tuesday or \$750 for three classes each Tuesday. A charge of \$25 per participant would be required. The program was approved (Moved-Tuttle, Seconded Close)

#### **Director Update**

Director Beal updated the Board regarding the Air Test/Fire Suppression and vent issue at the little league food stand. Director Beal noted that volleyball is on hold as no gyms are currently available, and volleyball will likely return next year after Biddy Buddy season has concluded.

#### Other Items

Chair Tuttle informed the Board that the Cacapon State Park dog park is under construction near the Batt Picnic shelter. Chair Tuttle noted also that there are miles of new bike trails at Cacapon and there is a large bike race coming with over 200 participants, and that new bike trails are still being added mostly through grants and by volunteers.

The Board noted that elections of officers had been postponed due to Covid issues and that elections will take place at the June meeting. It was also noted that the by-laws may need reviewed and amended.
