Civil Service Test will take place on July 24, 2024 at 6 p.m. at Blue Ridge Community College, 109 War Memorial Drive, Berkeley Springs, WV 25411.

Minimum Requirements are:

- Must be 18 years old and a U.S. citizen
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent
- Must be in excellent health (standard weight in proportion to height)
- Must **SUCCESSFULLY** pass all examinations administered by Civil Service Commission
- Must be willing to submit to further examinations throughout hiring process such as psychological, drug test and polygraph
- Must pass fitness standards for acceptance to police academy
- Must successfully pass medical examination
- Must attend and successfully complete all training as required for position
- Must be willing to accept duty assignments and all other duties assigned by the Sheriff of Morgan County.

Deputies who live within a 25-mile radius of the Morgan County Sheriff's Department will receive a take home vehicle.

Morgan County provides a comprehensive benefit package which includes: medical, optical, dental, vision and life insurance, paid vacation and sick leave.
