

Primary Election Explained

May 2026

Due to a change by the West Virginia Republican Party, ONLY voters registered as Republicans may vote a Republican Ballot in Primary Elections. We have made this chart to clarify the new rules:



VOTERS REGISTERED TO A SPECIFIC PARTY WILL <u>ONLY</u> BE ISSUED THE BALLOT OF THEIR PARTY.

<u>INDEPENDENT/NO PARTY AFFILIATION VOTERS:</u> YOU MAY CHOOSE A BALLOT OF A PARTY THAT ALLOWS YOUR PARTICIPATION. <u>IF YOU DO NOT EXPLICITLY ASK FOR A PARTY'S BALLOT, YOU WILL RECEIVE A NON-PARTISAN BALLOT.</u>

SOME PARTIES, SUCH AS THE LIBERTARIAN PARTY, DO NOT HOLD A PRIMARY ELECTION AND WILL NOT HAVE A BALLOT.

THIS ONLY APPLIES TO PRIMARY ELECTIONS, AS THE GENERAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER IS NOT PARTY SPECIFIC.
